Translation of a letter from Maulana Adam Saheb

A request is made to our Muslim Brotherhood to recognize that the acquisition of Halal foods is a mandatory duty upon one and all.

The Qur'anic injunction: "and eat from the earth that which is Halal and Pure," testifies to this, as well as this it brands the consumption of Haram foods as that of the satanic order. The tradition of our beloved Prophet and Messenger (peace and blessings of Allah be showered upon him), further warns "that entity which derives nourishment from even a single morsel of Haram food will not be able to enter paradise.
