Pastries:

- Chilean Empanada** £1.49
Wheat flour pastry stuffed with diced beef slowly cooked with subtle spices and onions filled with a slice of boiled egg and black olive.
- Guatemalan Tamal** £1.49
Tender pieces of chicken slowly cooked in rich tomato sauce with peppers. Stuffed in a soft corn dough and boiled in a banana leaf wrap leaving a moist texture.
- Venezuelan Arepa** £1.49
Seasoned pulled beef cooked with peppers and tomatoes sandwiched between a pan cooked bread made from corn flour.
- Brazilian Coxinha** £1.49
A deep-fried croquette of shredded chicken wrapped in cooked dough and covered with breadcrumbs for a crunchy texture.
- Colombian Empanada** £1.49
Lightly seasoned shredded beef cooked with potatoes stuffed in a cooked corn pastry deep fried.

Main Dishes:

All Served with a side of Rice. (Except Ceviche)

- Ceviche** £5.99
A renowned Peruvian dish of fresh sea bass fillets naturally cooked in lime juice and then mixed with finely chopped red onion, coriander. Served on a bed of lettuce with sweet potato and roasted kernels of corn.
- Milanesa Napolitana** £5.49
Italian influenced Argentinian thin steak of beef covered in breadcrumbs and shallow fried. Topped with tomato sauce, turkey ham and mozzarella cheese.
- Locro de Papas** £4.49
A creamy Ecuadorian stew of potatoes cooked with subtle spices, garnished with avocado and cubes of soft cheese.
- Ropa Vieja** £5.49
A Cuban dish of pulled beef slowly cooked in many varieties of subtle spices accompanied with fried plantain and black beans.
- Mole** £4.99
This is a 'Marmite' type of authentic Mexican dish where many opinions are divided. Chicken breast slowly cooked in a rich dark nutty sauce with exotic spicy flavors from native dried chilies and chocolate. (Please note, the unusual strong flavor may not be recommended for first time triers or people with sensitive taste buds.)

Desserts:

Arroz con Leche £1.49

A favorite of the continent. Rice pudding made with raisins and vanilla.

Flan £1.99

Another continent favourite made from egg, vanilla and caramel.

Tres Leches £1.49

Made from 3 types of milk, this simple cake is very popular in central America.

Soft drinks:

Traditional £1.00

Served cold in 250ml bottles.

Horchata

A Mexican favorite of creamy rice-based drink infused with cinnamon and vanilla.

Chicha Morada

A famous Peruvian drink made with purple corn boiled with pineapple and wood spices.

Tereré

The Paraguayan version of iced tea made from yerba mate leaves.
